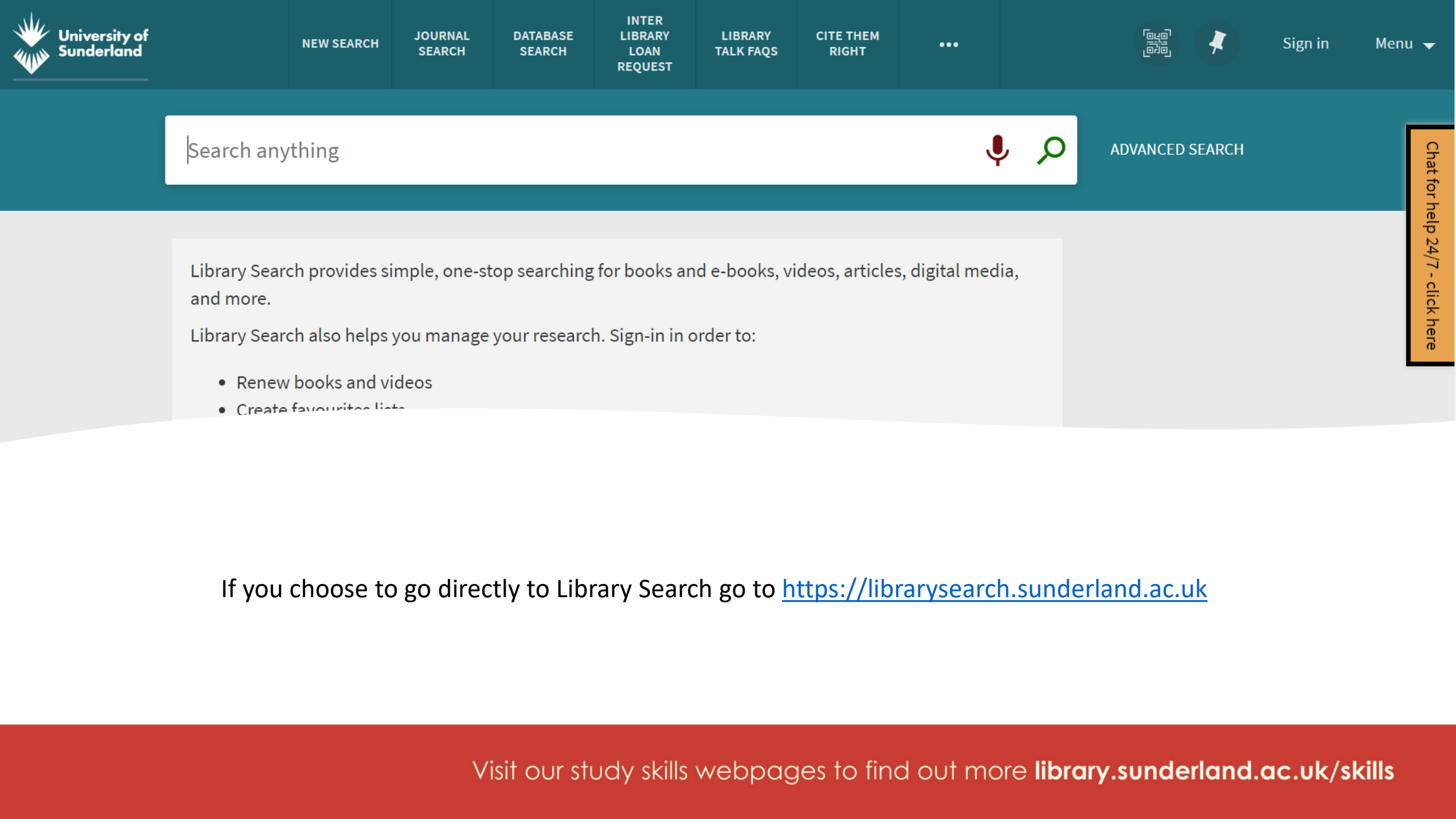
To search for eBooks you can use the search box on the library home page

Select 'Available online' and 'Books'

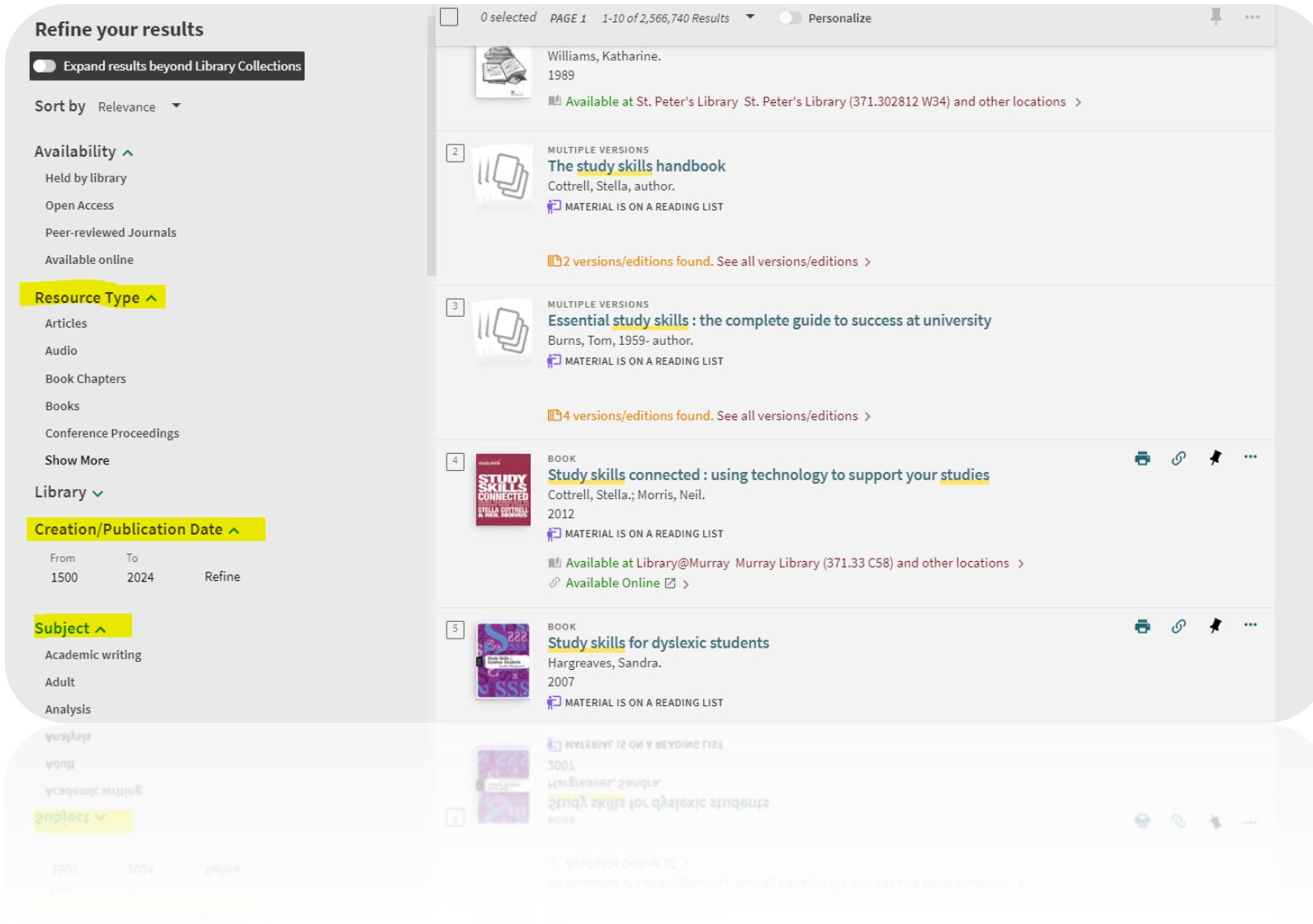

Read the book online

We usually recommend this option if you have access to the internet when you read the book as it offers interactive features such as:

- Adding personalised notes to pages
- Keyword search the full text

Why can't I find the title I need as an eBook?

Unfortunately, not all titles are available for us to buy as eBooks. If a book is on your reading list, and an ebook version is available, we will buy it.

Why does it only let me read an eBook for 5 minutes?

It sounds like you're either not logged in, or you are trying to read an eBook that the University of Sunderland does not subscribe to. You will often be able to view a short preview of a book, but you will only be able to read it fully if we subscribe to it. Always begin at Library Search to ensure you're accessing our subscriptions.

Can I print out an eBook?

You are usually able to print out a small portion of the eBook. Look for the print option when you're reading online this will tell you how many pages you can print.
