


To search for ebooks you can use the search box on the library home page or you can go directly to **the Library Catalogue**.

You can also further refine by subject, author or year published.





Visit the Off Campus web page and copy and paste the text inside the box into the body of your email.



Why can't I find the title I need as an ebook?

Unfortunately not all titles are available for us to buy as ebooks. If a book is on your reading list, and an ebook version is available, we will buy it.

How can I access the title if an ebook version is not available?

If you're studying at a partner centre, check to see if your home library has a copy. If not we may be able to obtain a part of the book (usually one chapter) for you through the free Document Delivery Service.

Why does it only let me read an ebook for 5 minutes?

It sounds like you're either not logged in, or you are trying to read an ebook that the University of Sunderland does not subscribe to.

You will often be able to view a short preview of a book, but you will only be able to read it fully if we subscribe to it.

Always begin at the Library Catalogue to ensure you're accessing our subscriptions.

Can I print out an ebook?

You are usually able to print out a small portion of the ebook. Look for the print option when you're reading online.
